***1. APPROVAL OF THE JULY 14, 2009 BOARD OF EXAMINERS' MEETING MINUTES**

***2. FURLOUGH EXCEPTIONS**

Pursuant to Senate Bill 433, Section 5.2 (a) of the 2009 Legislative Session, the State Board of Examiners shall determine positions within the Executive Branch of State Government that cannot be subject to furlough leave.

A. Office of the Military

The Office of the Military requests exception for fifteen positions based on the mandated minimum staffing levels required for public safety. This exception would be for the time period of August 2009 to June 2011 at a cost of \$28,397.76 which is 100% federally funded.

B. Department of Corrections

The Department of Corrections requests exceptions for the month of August for multiple positions necessary for public safety at a cost of approximately \$630,172. This request replicates the July request with the exception of medical staff, which have been withdrawn and will be taking furlough for the month of August and September, 2009. During the July 14th, 2009 Board of Examiners meeting, Director Skolnik indicated the department would develop a biennial plan to implement Senate Bill 433 and the plan would be presented to the Board at its August 11th meeting.

***3. VICTIM OF CRIME PROGRAM APPEAL**

Mark and Victoria Labianca are appealing a decision of the Appeals Officer which denied their relocation request.

***4. VICTIM OF CRIME POLICIES**

The Victim of Crime (VOC) Program Coordinator is submitting VOC Program policies for adoption by the Board of Examiners. This is an 89 page document. This document can be found on their website at www.voc.nv.gov.

***5. VICTIMS OF CRIME 2009 4TH QUARTER REPORT AND 2010 1ST QUARTER RECOMMENDATION**

NRS217.260 requires the Board of Examiners to estimate available revenue and anticipated claim costs each quarter. If revenues are insufficient to pay anticipated claims, the statute directs that claim payments must be reduced proportionately. The Victims of Crime Program Coordinator recommends paying the claims at 100% of the approved amount for the 1st quarter of fiscal year 2010.

***6. DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION**

The Department of Taxation requests approval to destroy \$5,999,150 spoiled or unusable cigarette tax stamps pursuant to NRS 370.230 at a face value of \$2,715,964. Of the total, \$3,253,863 stamps have been returned for refund by the cigarette wholesalers from late 1970's through September 2009 and \$2,745,287 stamps have discontinued denominations.
