SUBJECT:

State Mileage Reimbursement Rate

The federal government has recently increased the standard mileage rate for transportation expenses from 51 cents per mile to 55.5 cents per mile effective July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011. The allowable state mileage rate for the use of personal vehicles in the conduct of state business either at the direction of the state agency or for the personal convenience of the employee is adjusted periodically to reflect the allowable federal rate. On the basis of the change in the federal standard mileage rate, the state mileage reimbursement rates are as follows:

- 1. For an employee using his/her own personal vehicle for the State's convenience, the mileage reimbursement rate has <u>increased from 51 cents per mile to 55.5 cents per mile</u>.
- 2. For an employee using his/her own personal vehicle for the employee's convenience, the employee will be reimbursed at one-half the standard mileage reimbursement rate, which has been <u>increased from</u> 25.5 cents per mile to 27.75 cents per mile.

These rates are effective July 1, 2011.
