### \*4. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION – REQUEST FOR ALLOCATION FROM THE FUND FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION OF FACILITIES FOR PRISON INDUSTRIES

### A. Department of Corrections – Prison Industries – \$28,376

Pursuant to NRS 209.192, the Department of Corrections, Prison Industries, requests to access \$28,376 from the Fund for New Construction of Facilities for Prison Industries.
