#### \*4. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION – AUTHORIZATION TO CONTRACT WITH A FORMER EMPLOYEE

#### A. Office of the Controller

Pursuant to NRS 284.1729, Section1, Subsection 1-2, the Controller's Office requests authority to contract with a former employee, on a part-time basis through the use of a temporary service, so this individual, who retired on May 24, 2013, may train the new employee on their debt collection duties in an effort to transfer knowledge without an additional loss in debt collection productivity. # \*5. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION – AUTHORITY TO PAY MINING CLAIM REFUNDS

#### A. Department of Taxation – \$43,875
