Pursuant to NRS 353.268, the Governor's Finance Office requests a recommendation to the Interim Finance Committee for an allocation of \$30,000,000 from the Interim Finance Committee Account to support funding to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada and Three Squares Food Bank in Southern Nevada.

The federal government shutdown that began on October 1, 2025, is currently ongoing, marking the second-longest shutdown in U.S. history, with significant impacts on federal employees and services.

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is one of the benefits that has or will be affected in Nevada. SNAP is designed to alleviate food insecurity by providing eligible households with monthly benefits that can be used to buy food at authorized retailers. Starting November 1, 2025, the SNAP recipients will not receive their benefit. To alleviate food insecurity, the Governor's Finance Office is requesting an allocation to support the food banks.

This request will also support food for the individuals and families who's were furloughed or laid off due to the federal shutdown.
